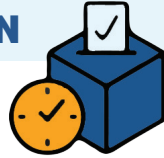

Drive-through early voting

During early voting at auditor's office, they will send someone out to the car to help a voter that can't come into the office. Call them in advance to let them know you are coming: 319-642-3923

Weekend hours at the Auditor's Office

ID is required

- Iowa driver's license
- Iowa non-operator ID
- Iowa Voter ID card (*with PIN*)
- Out-of-state driver's license—with proof of current Iowa address

RETURN YOUR BALLOT

By mail: Your ballot must reach the Auditor's Office by Nov 5 at 8pm, so put your ballot in the mail by Oct 29

By hand:


- Hand the ballot to the Auditor's Office staff
- Ask a relative to return your ballot
- Call the Auditor's Office for help: 319-642-3923

VOTE ON ELECTION DAY



TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 5
7am–8pm

WHERE TO VOTE

- On Election Day, vote at your precinct polling place (*not at the Auditor's Office*)
- **To find your polling place** 



ID is required

- Iowa driver's license
- Iowa non-operator ID
- Iowa Voter ID card (*with PIN*)
- Out-of-state driver's license—with proof of current Iowa address

If you have moved

If your ID doesn't show your current address, you'll be asked for proof of address (*paper or digital*) with your name, current address, valid within the last 45 days. Examples:

- Utility bill
- Cell phone bill
- Bank statement
- Paycheck

YOU CAN REGISTER AND VOTE AT THE SAME TIME!
